

W.O.R.D.

Introduction: The W.O.R.D. study method is a simple way to let God's Word sink deeper into your life. Each step helps you move from hearing to living the message. Use it during your personal devotions, in small groups, or as you reflect on Sunday's teaching.

W – What happened? (Objective)

Name the facts. What is the situation, story, or teaching?

Ask: "What do I see? What is actually happening here?"

O – Open heart (Reflective)

What feelings, memories, or experiences does this bring up?

Ask: "How does this connect to my life, my joys, or my struggles?"

R – Reveal meaning (Interpretive)

What truth or message is God revealing here?

Ask: "What does this teach me about God, myself and others?"

D – Do it (Decisional)

What step of obedience, faith, or action will I take?

Ask: "What's one thing I can practice or live out this week?"
