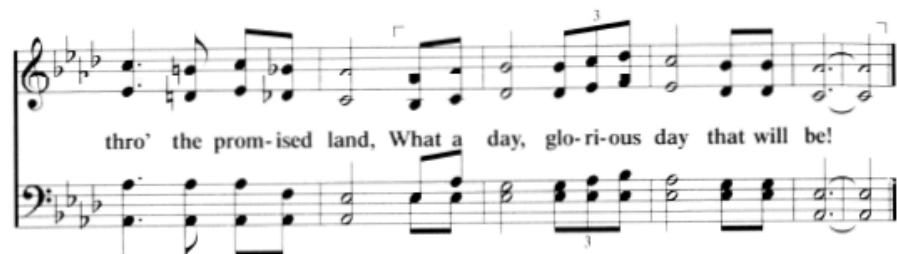
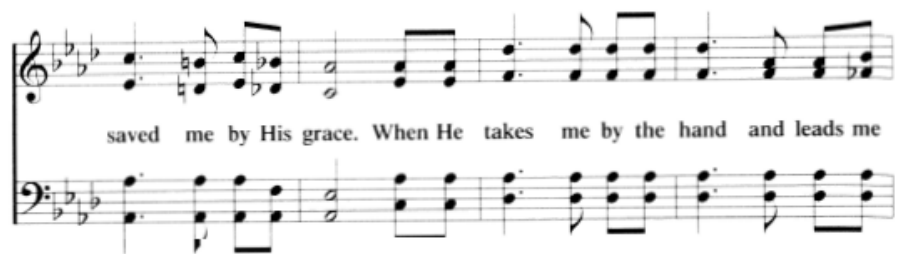
The Passi Family - Called to Canada

I, Arun Passi along with my wife Anjana and sons Daniel & Joel, have been in Canada for almost 3 years. We are serving with Multiply Network among the Punjabi community. I served as a pastor, overseer and mentor for over a decade in North India. We've been actively involved in church planting and discipleship since 2009. Anjana led a women's ministry, and served as a strong companion in church planting. Our kids were also involved in ministry as we would go as a family for visits, cottage prayer meetings and house churches almost every day. In 2018, God birthed a vision of moving to Canada to help churches in reaching out to our Punjabi neighbors.

It has been a very exciting, challenging and a learning experience for us. It's **exciting** because God brought us here with no knowledge of Canadian culture and context. It's **challenging** because the culture here has shaped our own community in a different way than we anticipated. Our Punjabi community has adapted into western culture. It takes time to understand and process this new personality development of our people. It's a **learning** experience because we are students of this culture and have had to observe and learn how to minister differently than in India. God led us to Canada with a vision to reach to our own culture and language community with the help of our faith community of Christian brothers and sisters.

In this stage of life and ministry in Canada, we are learning to be listeners of people's life stories, getting the ideas and strategies of building intentional relationships and loving our neighbors like ourselves at all costs. It's our hope and prayer to encourage churches to be on mission, reaching out to the communities that live in our neighborhoods with a never-ending love. This is a collaborative mission, and the victory cannot be celebrated individually.
